Scholarships for Overseas Students 2023
Guidelines for Applicants

Qualifications: Overseas students accepted for study at Kobe College or Kobe College Graduate School who show academic ability and keen interest for study or research, and who are in need of financial support.

Amount: 30,000 yen per month, payable for a 6-month period while the recipient is in attendance at Kobe College or Kobe College Graduate School. Recipients may apply for a single extension.

Number of scholarships awarded: Two

Selection process: In accordance with this program's regulations, recipients are decided at the Megumi Association Board Meeting, following a screening process undertaken by the Scholarship Screening Committee.

Payment: By bank transfer to the recipient's bank account at the end of each month.
(Charges will be covered by Megumi Association)

Requirements: At the end of the scholarship, recipients must submit to the International Exchange Center a "Report on Benefits of Overseas Study" addressed to the President of the Megumi Association.

Documents required for application:

- 1) Application form
- 2) College transcript
- 3) Copy of Application for Certificate of Eligibility

Submitted documents will not be returned.

How to apply: Documents may be presented in person or sent by post.
Documents received after the application period closes will not be considered.
